

**TIMBERLAKE CIVIC ASSOCIATION MEETING  
MINUTES FROM  
October 7, 2008**

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm

The secretary's minutes were accepted as read.

The Treasurer's report showed a beginning balance for the month and an ending balance. The treasurer's report was accepted as read.

We have a new newspaper in the area, The Willowbrook / Burr Ridge Independent. It is published the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of each month. It is free, but you need to sign up for it. Not everyone got a copy. The Doings endorsed Linda Painter for the Forest Preserve board.

The Burr Ridge Farmers' Market is over for the season.

Linda talked to DuPage County Board member Jeff Reddick about having either someone from USDA or Tom back for our March meeting to discuss gypsy moth control.

Residents reported that there are trees down on 91<sup>st</sup> Street. We need to call either the Forest Preserve District or the township.

Linda reported that Andy Anderson said the township will re-gravel the path on 91<sup>st</sup> Street either this fall or next spring.

We still have signs for sale at \$10 each. They can be mounted on a 4 foot fence post available at Menards.

Brush pickup has begun. We are in the middle of the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of pickup for West side of Clarendon Hills Road. The township will start road patching soon. There is a large pothole on South Frontage Road East of Cass. A streetlight is out at 87<sup>th</sup> and Clarendon Hills Road. For that we need to call Com Ed.

Kyle Gilgis via Linda Painter: The board tried to take Hanson to the states attorney, but there was not enough to prosecute him. He paid the siding fine and renewed his permit.

The November meeting will be in a different room at the library. We will be back to our usual room for the December meeting. We can only reserve rooms 3 months in advance. District 86 bought the old Kindercare building. It may be an option for future meetings. Gower West charges more than the old place.

The Timberlake Women's Club is charging only \$27 for a night at a horseracing park. Next month they will be attending a play at Old Town. See Charlotte for more details.

Absentee ballots were available at the meeting. Early voting location lists were distributed. Early voting will occur October 13 – 30. There will be no referendum from Cass but there will be a referendum to change the Illinois State Constitution. Linda can register voters.

Nominating Committee members were selected: Norm Mareci, Doug Jones, John Curcio and Linda Painter. The audit committee will be nominated in November. The Scholarship committee will consist of Norm Mareci, John Curcio, and Bernie Nemchausky.
