February 2, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 p.m.

The treasurer's report was accepted as read. Treasurer, Doug Jones, explained the new format for our Treasurer's report. Our books are now on Quick Books. Doug passed around a copy of the treasurer's year end review. Our sign account is in lieu of insuring the signs. Our signs are, in fact, self-insured. It was recommended that we have the budget and variances from it on the annual report.

Cell phone bills: Timberlake residents should not be paying the State/Municipal telecom tax or MTT or Willowbrook MTT tax. Take your base phone bill. Multiply that by 7% and by 13%. 7% is OK. 13% means you are paying the Willowbrook tax. We are not supposed to be paying into Willowbrook. Willowbrook is investigating. There will be an 11am meeting tomorrow in Willowbrook. Check other utility bills as well. There will be more info in March.

There was an article in the newspaper reporting that Burr Ridge wants its own zip code and that the Post Office is refusing their request. Mayor Grasso talked with Linda and is hopeful that if Timberlake and Tristate join with Burr Ridge, their request will carry more weight.

Our March and April meetings will be at the Indian Prairie Library. From May through December we need to find another meeting room. Linda will look into it.
