

**TIMBERLAKE CIVIC ASSOCIATION MEETING
MINUTES FROM
February 5, 2008**

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m.

Doug Jones read the treasurer's report showing a beginning balance of \$14,570.74 and an ending balance of \$16,270.74. The treasurer's report was approved as read.

The secretary's report was accepted as read.

As of last Wednesday, Timberlake is receiving Lake Michigan water.

Voter registration will re-open the day after tomorrow.

Essence Suites: There has been no word.

Potholes: All the potholes have been patched including the giant one on Route 83. Residents reported that new potholes are appearing by the bridge and on Scheel.

We have started a letter writing campaign to urge the Forest Preserve District to acquire the Scheel property. Lists of salient reasons to purchase the land have been distributed. All residents are encouraged to write or e-mail the FPD commissioners.

Doug Jones announced that street signs are in production. He will call when they are ready.

Thanks to all for voting. As of 4 o'clock this afternoon over 700 residents had voted and the voting site was packed at 6. This has been the largest turnout ever.
